- 27 in-line officers, ADF and civilian advisers and liaison officers provide in-country support to the Defence Cooperation Program.
- Pacific Patrol Boat Program Four Pacific Patrol Boats.
- Project Halivim Poroman (Barracks Refurbishment Program) A\$1 million per financial year.
- Contracted lease of two helicopters to the PNGDF from 2012-2014.
- Training:
 - On average, 20 Australia-based long-term military training positions each year for PNG defence personnel.
 - Focuses on basic and intermediate Army and Navy skills (such as engineering and navigation courses).
 - Includes positions at Australian Defence College and Royal Military College.
 - Funding and advisory support also provided for the conduct of in-country training courses in PNG.
- Support to PNG participation in UN Peacekeeping Operations.


