## NOTARIAL SERVICES FEES FROM 1 FEBRUARY 2023

In accordance with Australia's Consular Fees Act 1955, fees apply for notarial services payable in local currency. Fees paid for notarial services are non-refundable.

Local currency fees are reviewed monthly and adjusted to reflect local currency exchange rate variations of +/- 3%.
