Visitor (subclass 600) visa – Business Visitor or Tourist streams

 Application Form – you must answer all questions completely and accurately Form 1415 – Business Visitor stream OR Form 1419 – Tourist stream Attach one (1) recent passport photo of yourself to the front page 	
Passport Biographical Data Page – include a copy of the biographical data page of the passport you will use for travel, plus any pages with validity extensions/other relevant details • Passports need to be valid for at least the period of your planned stay in Australia	
Family Composition – include a completed copy of Form 54 Family composition (with additional pages if you have a large family)	
Purpose of Your Visit – include evidence of why you wish to travel to Australia: Business Visitor – evidence of the business need to visit Australia and why you are required to travel for that business Tourist – evidence you are visiting family, travelling for tourism, undertaking a short course or competing in an amateur sports event	
 Evidence of Funds – include evidence you have adequate funds, or access to adequate funds, to support your stay in Australia (e.g. savings, employment with salary details, business ownership) – this may include your employer's financial support if you are travelling for business It is up to you to demonstrate you have adequate funds. Evidence of support from family, friends, or some other person or organisation in Australia is likely to be given less weight than evidence you provide 	
Authorised Contact – if you wish the Department to communicate with someone else about your application then complete the appropriate form: • Form 956 – Registered Migration Agent / exempt person OR • Form 956A – Authorised recipient	
 Under 18 Years Old – if you are under 18 years old you must provide your birth certificate, and if you are travelling without one or both parents you need to provide evidence of consent to the grant of a visa: Form 1229 – completed only by your parents (not step-parents) or other person(s) who have a legal right to decide where you live Identity documents – of the person(s) giving their consent (copies) Custody order – if you have been adopted by an order from a court Form 1257 – completed by a responsible person (over the age of 21) who will care for you if you are not travelling with your parents and not travelling as part of a tour/staying with relatives
